



**ORIS DANCE COVID-19 CORONAVIRUS NOTICE  
SEPTEMBER 2020**

Dear All

We have been planning our return to classes for some months now and we have prepared a detailed note of all the changes that will affect our dancers when we return to classes. This has been emailed out and can also be found in the members' area of our website. We invite you to take the time to read this.

In summary, we set out below the main steps that we have taken/are taking to ensure a safe return to classes:

1. conducting risk assessments and liaising with our venues in relation to their risk assessments;
2. liaising with our insurance and the Environmental Health Office at St Helens Council;
3. reviewing Government Guidance and advice from our associated dancing bodies;
4. reduced class numbers;
5. a designated area for each dancer to dance in;
6. set breaks between classes to allow for class change overs, cleaning and sanitising;
7. one-way systems in place at venues and hand overs between parents and teachers at the entrances and exits;
8. dancers' temperatures will be taken on arrival and dancers must not attend class if displaying any of the recognised COVID-19 symptoms;
9. hand sanitiser must be used at least before and after class;
10. use of PPE in class;
11. online payments only.
